The Ohio School for the Deaf is considering outsourcing the mowing of two large fields on its property.

The primary project will be mowing a large field north of Morse Road, accessible by Indianola Avenue. The scope of work for this project will be to mow this field weekly to a height of 4” to 5”. One requirement for this project is you must be insured. There is no trimming or weed eating involved for this project.

The secondary project is to mow, trim and weed eat a large field on the campus of OSD. The scope of work for this project will be to mow the field weekly to a height of 4” to 5”. The requirements for this project are you must be insured and anyone performing the work on the campus must have a current BCI and FBI background check on file at the campus.

We welcome any vendor to bid on these projects. We would like to see individual bids for each project area and if you are able, another bid that would package them together.
