Salary Theorem

The less you know, the more you make.
Proof:

Postulate 1: **Knowledge** is **Power**.

Postulate 2: **Time** is **Money**.

As every engineer knows: **Power** = **Work** / **Time**

And since **Knowledge** = **Power** and **Time** = **Money**

It is therefore true that **Knowledge** = **Work** / **Money** .

Solving for **Money**, we get:

Money = **Work** / **Knowledge**

Thus, as **Knowledge** approaches zero, **Money** approaches infinity, regardless of the amount of **Work**
