Job Duties:

Assists young children in developing readiness for kindergarten by developing and implementing learning goals/lessons plans that are appropriate for students and aligned with the school's curriculum and/or State standards; assuring that students make connections between current content, previously learned content, and content that remains to be learned; expanding students' linguistic skills; creating and selecting teaching methods, learning activities, and instructional materials that are appropriate for students and aligned with the curriculum; facilitating play/learn activities to enhance the development of reading and numeracy skills, world knowledge, fine motor, and gross motor skills; creating a warm, nurturing classroom environment that promotes equity; interacting with children using positive language; modeling cooperative behavior that reflects mutual respect and problem solving; establishing routines and cultural expectations; assuring student safety indoors and outdoors; teaming with education aides to implement programming. Plans, assesses, and monitors student progress by developing IEP/IFSP plans and documenting progress; referring students for related services as needed; communicating with parents, local school districts, and case managers about student's progress at least twice per year; conducting parent-teacher conferences including possible home visits; maintaining records on student performance areas and attendance, including teacher notes, portfolios, current assessment methodologies, etc., to reflect growth in linguistic, fine motor, gross motor, cognitive, and socialization skills

Minimum Qualifications

Ohio certification/licensure in Deaf education and /or early childhood education. Fluency in ASL at the advanced level on the SLPI. Ohio driver's license preferred.

Conditions for Employment: Employment is contingent upon successful completion of criminal BCI/FBI background check. The final applicant for this position will be required to submit to urinalysis prior to appointment to test for illegal drug use. An applicant with a positive test result will not be offered employment. Unless otherwise instructed, submit a separate application or resume for each job opportunity posting in which you are interested. You must demonstrate on your application how you meet the minimum qualifications for this position.
